1SEC. 2. TEMPORARY TREATMENT OF CERTAIN APPLICA-2TIONS FOR THE EXPORTATION OF NATURAL3GAS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—During the period described in
5 subsection (c) of this section, for purposes of section 3(a)
6 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717b(a)), the expor7 tation of natural gas to a foreign country described in sub8 section (b) of this section shall be deemed to be consistent
9 with the public interest, and applications for such expor10 tation shall be granted without modification or delay.

(b) FOREIGN COUNTRIES.—A foreign country de-scribed in this subsection is—

13 (1) a member country of the North Atlantic14 Treaty Organization; or

(2) any other foreign country, if the Secretary
of State, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of Energy, determines that
exportation of natural gas to that foreign country
would promote the national security interests of the
United States.

(c) APPLICABILITY.—This section shall apply with respect to applications for the authorization to export natural gas under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15
U.S.C. 717b) to a foreign country described in subsection
(b) of this section that are pending on the date of enactment of this Act, or filed during the period that begins

- 1 on such date of enactment and ends on the date that is
- 2 3 years after such date of enactment.
