1 SEC. 2. RISK-COMMUNICATION STRATEGY.

The Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall develop a risk-communication strategy to inform the public about the hazards or potential hazards of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or categories of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, by—

8 (1) disseminating information about the risks 9 or potential risks posed by such substances or cat-10 egories in land, air, water (including drinking water 11 and water used for agricultural purposes), and prod-12 ucts;

13 (2) notifying the public about exposure path14 ways and mitigation measures through outreach and
15 educational resources; and

18 best practices in developing a national risk-commu19 nication strategy.
