SEC. 2. BAN ON CERTAIN SUBSTANCES IN COSMETIC PROD UCTS.

3 Section 601 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic

4 Act (21 U.S.C. 361) is amended—

5 (a) by adding at the end the following:

6 "(h) If it contains intentionally added dibutyl phthal-7 ate (CAS no. 84-74-2), diethylhexyl phthalate (CAS no. 8 117-81-7). (CAS formaldehyde no. 50-00-0),9 paraformaldehyde (CAS no. 30525-89-4), methylene gly-10 col (CAS no. 463-57-0), guaternium-15 (CAS no. 7439-97-6), mercury (CAS no. 7439-97-6), isobutylparaben 11 (CAS no. 4247-02-3), isopropylparaben (CAS no. 4191-12 73-5), m-Phenylenediamine (including the salts of such 13 14 substance) (CAS no. 108-45-2), and o-Phenylenediamine (including the salts of such substance) (CAS no. 95-54-15 16 5)..".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 601(h) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as added by subsection (a), shall apply with respect to cosmetics introduced or delivered into introduction into interstate commerce beginning on January 1, 2025.
