



Instructions and Checklist

Applications for a military service academy nomination from Congresswoman Fletcher need to be submitted by November 6, 2020. Late applications will not be accepted.

Required Materials:

PART I

Application for nomination: Complete entire application form. Be sure to sign and date.

- Please provide a recent photograph

PART II

Recommendation Letters

- Please provide 3 letters of recommendation from people who know you personally. Letters should not be written by any relative.

PART III

Resume: Submit a one-page resume that includes extracurricular activities and employment history starting in 9th grade.

PART IV

Essay: Submit a one-page essay on the topic: *“What does military service mean to you personally?”*

PART V

Materials from your school

- Official academic transcripts from all high schools and/or colleges attended
- Standardized test scores (*ACT or SAT – may be included on your transcript*)

Please mail or bring in your completed, signed, and dated application packet to Congresswoman Fletcher's office. All materials MUST be received or postmarked by Friday, November 6, 2020.
