- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Texas Flood Emer-
- 5 gency Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2025".

1 SEC. 2. EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR

- 3 (a) In General.—In addition to amounts otherwise
- 4 available, there is appropriated for fiscal year 2025, out
- 5 of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
- 6 \$15,000,000,000, to remain available until expended, to
- 7 the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management
- 8 Assistance Agency for necessary expenses in carrying out
- 9 the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency As-
- 10 sistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.) for major disasters
